Operating instructions

1. Safety instructions

Electrical equipment must only be installed and assembled by a qualified electrician in accordance with the relevant installation standards, directives, determinations and safety and accident prevention directives of the country.

Failure to comply with these instructions may result in damage to the device, fire or other hazards.

Hazard due to electric shock. Do not operate device without the application module.

These instructions are an integral component of the product, and must be retained by the end user.

2. Design of the device




Figure 1: Power supply

- (1) Power supply
- (2) Frame
- (3) Application module e.g. from a radio push-button
- (4) Screw for dismantling protection (not R.1/R.3)
- (5) Radio button design cover
- (6) Connecting terminals

3. Function

Correct use

- Mains supply for radio application modules
- Only suitable for use in indoor areas, no drip or spray water.
- Installation in wall box according to DIN 49073.
- Operate with suitable application module (see Chapter 6.2, "Accessories")

4. Operation

These instructions describe the installation of the power supply. The operation is described in the instructions of the respective application module.



5. Information for electricians

5.1 Assembly and electrical circuiting

Touching live parts can result in an electric shock.

Disconnect the connecting cables before working on the device and cover all live parts in the area!

Circuiting and mounting the power supply




Figure 2: Power supply circuiting diagram

A MCB max. 16 A is installed as device protection.

- Connect power supply according to circuiting diagram (Figure 2).
- Mount the mains insert in a wall box. The connecting terminals must be at the bottom.
- Attach the frame and application module (see instructions for application module).
